

FIRST GRADE SUMMER MATH

The Akiva math program is a balance of teaching conceptual understanding and procedural accuracy. Each grade level has certain concepts as well as procedures and math facts that they are responsible for teaching. **First graders should enter the class already knowing all of their addition and subtraction up to 5+5, automatically. In first grade, they will learn addition and subtraction facts up to 10+10.** It is vital that students know all the facts in order for them to be successful with the new concepts and procedures that they will learn next school year. **Students do have a summer slide if they do not practice, so please encourage your child to practice math facts for a few minutes each day.** The practice will definitely pay off!

Ways to Practice All of the Addition and Subtraction Facts up to 5.
